Working closely with multi-disciplinary staff you will be responsible for a wide variety of performance analysis roles. You will satisfy the ever-evolving demands within our environment, supporting the coaching staff in terms of pre, live, post-match and training analysis: with the aim of improving on-field performance.

Key responsibilities (but not limited to):

- Lead and oversee the club's Performance Analyst department
- Review, and code, opposition match footage and provide insights to the relevant coaching staff and create detailed analysis presentations to facilitate game plan and game reviews
- Produce post-match videos and reports for the coaching staff
- Video editing of pre match videos (set plays presentations, unit meetings)
- Penalty taker analysis for upcoming opponents
- Filming and coding of training sessions to aid with pre match preparations
